

# Islington Sustainable Energy Partnership

Annual Report 2017/18

ISEP is so proud of the continuing carbon achievements of our members. In 2017/18 Partnership members achieved an average annual emissions reduction of nearly 7%. This is a whopping amount considering that many members have increased their numbers of staff and economic activity. That 7% saving is equivalent to the emissions produced to heat and power over 1200 homes for a year.

The average from all our members who've improved is that they've cut their emissions by 25% in under six years. When we take the decarbonisation of the grid into account, then all our members who reported this year have achieved an average emissions reduction of 35% in five years. ISEP represents over 15% of the borough's commercial carbon emissions

Well done everyone: we all stand in a strong position to set ambitious targets for 2030 and beyond.

Bringing members together to learn from each other is a key role of the Partnership. We facilitated **five events**, exploring topics such as sustainable transport, energy efficiency for small businesses, storytelling for a sustainable future and anti-idling action.

During the year ISEP members supported the UNFCCC's Climate Neutral initiative and also The Big Clean Switch.
